

Jamacho Day Hike Kathmandu - 1 Days

The Jamacho Day Hike in Kathmandu is an ideal option if you don't have much time but still want to spend a peaceful day in nature. It's just a few minutes' drive to Shivapuri Nagarjun National Park, Fulbari Gate, where the hike begins.

Trail

The Jamacho Day Hike in Kathmandu passes through a dense forest and is moderately steep in some sections. It takes approximately 3 hours to reach the top, and about 2 hours to return.

Jamacho Monastery (Gumba)

A small and peaceful Buddhist monastery at the top, adorned with colourful Tibetan prayer flags, offers a spiritual and serene atmosphere.

Panoramic Views

On clear days, you can see Ganesh Himal, the Langtang Range, and a wide, breathtaking view of the Kathmandu Valley.

Flora & Fauna

Since it lies within a national park, the area is home to monkeys, birds, butterflies, and other wild forest animals. During spring, you can also see seasonal flowers like rhododendrons blooming along the trail.
