DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu (1,330m)

Upon your arrival, a representative from Trek Curator will be there to warmly welcome you with a traditional garland. After the greeting, you'll be assisted with a private luxury transfer to your hotel. A briefing about your tour will follow, including an introduction to the team. Feel free to relax at your hotel or explore the bustling markets, cafés, or restaurants in Thamel during your free time. In the evening, indulge in authentic Nepali cuisine paired with a cultural performance.

Day 2: Full-Day Sightseeing in Kathmandu

After a delightful breakfast at the hotel, embark on a full day of cultural sightseeing in Kathmandu. Enjoy a private guided tour of major UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Your first stop will be the Swayambhunath Stupa, one of the largest Buddhist stupas, also known as the Monkey Temple. Here, you can take in breathtaking 360-degree views of the Kathmandu Valley. Next, visit Bouddhanath Stupa, a serene Buddhist monument that serves as a spiritual hub. Finally, explore Pashupatinath Temple, a revered Hindu pilgrimage site where you can witness the Aarti ceremony and observe open-air cremation rituals along the Bagmati River. Throughout the day, savour authentic Nepali lunch at local restaurants, experiencing the harmonious blend of Hindu and Buddhist cultures. Your day will conclude with a return to your hotel.

Day 3: Kathmandu to Pokhara (Flight) + Sightseeing (822m)

Start your day with breakfast, then head to the airport for a scenic morning flight to Pokhara. This 25-30 minute journey will offer stunning aerial views of the Himalayas, verdant hills, and picturesque villages. Once in Pokhara, you'll be transferred to a luxurious lakeside resort. Spend some time unwinding at the resort before setting off for an exploration of Pokhara city. You'll visit Davis Falls, an intriguing underground waterfall, followed by Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, a sacred Shiva shrine nestled within limestone caverns. Next, head to Bindhyabasini Temple, a significant Hindu pilgrimage site, and wrap up your day with a serene boating experience on Fewa Lake, visiting Tal Barahi Temple. In the evening, relax at your resort or enjoy a stroll along the lakeside while watching the sun set over the Annapurna range.

Day 4: Pokhara to Jomsom flight and drive muktinath (3,700m) - Jomsom (2,743m)

From Pokhara, enjoy an early morning scenic flight to Jomsom, a gateway to Upper Mustang, where you'll witness the impressive Dhaulagiri and Nilgiri mountain ranges. Upon arrival in Jomsom, your journey continues with a two-hour drive through the dramatic Kaligandaki Gorge towards Muktinath. Here, after visiting the sacred 108 water spouts, you can partake in ritual purification. Discover the Eternal Flame at Jwala Mai Temple, a symbol of spiritual energy, and the Main Vishnu Temple, significant to both Hindus and Buddhists. If time allows, consider a visit to the nearby Jharkot Monastery. Later in the afternoon, return to Jomsom, where you can take some time to explore the village or visit the local market, perhaps even enjoy a horse ride. Spend the night at the best available lodge or boutique mountain hotel in Jomsom.

Day 5: Jomsom to pokhara flight (822m)

Begin your day with a morning flight back to Pokhara, taking in views of the majestic Himalayas once more. After landing, you will be transferred to your resort. Enjoy some free time during which you can engage in various activities, such as visiting the World Peace Pagoda for panoramic views of Phewa Lake and Annapurna. You might also explore the International Mountain Museum, where you can learn about Nepal's rich mountaineering heritage. In the evening, take the opportunity to browse the lakeside market for local crafts and souvenirs, and consider dining at a lakeside restaurant featuring live music (optional).

Day 6: Flight from Pokhara to Kathmandu - Drive to Nagarkot (2,195m)

After breakfast, catch a morning flight back to Kathmandu. Once you arrive, you'll embark on a drive to Nagarkot, a picturesque hilltop known for its stunning sunrise and Himalayan views. Upon reaching, check into a premium hill resort. Enjoy some free time to unwind or embark on nature walks in the surrounding area. Weather permitting, consider having evening tea while soaking in views of the Langtang and Everest ranges. Spend the night at a luxury resort in Nagarkot.

Day 7: Nagarkot Sunrise - Bhaktapur - Kathmandu (1,330m)

Wake up early to witness a spectacular sunrise over the Himalayas, which may even include a glimpse of Mt. Everest on clear days. Savour breakfast against a breathtaking mountain backdrop before departing for Bhaktapur, famed as a living museum of medieval art and culture. In Bhaktapur, explore the Nyatapola Temple, the 55-Window Palace, and Pottery Square. Don't miss the chance to sample local Newari snacks and the renowned "Jaju Dhau" yoghurt. Afterwards, return to Kathmandu, where you can visit the tranquil Garden of Dreams. Celebrate your journey with a farewell dinner

featuring a Nepali cultural performance.

Day 8: Departure

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and a relaxed morning at the hotel, tailored to your flight schedule. Afterwards, you will have a private transfer to Tribhuvan International Airport. There, a representative from the trek curator will bid you farewell with a traditional blessing scarf. This marks the end of your Luxury Muktinath Pilgrimage tour, leaving you with unforgettable memories and experiences to cherish for a lifetime.
