DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Kathmandu

Upon your arrival in Kathmandu, a representative will be waiting to greet you. They will welcome you to Nepal with a traditional lower garland and a tika ceremony before assisting you in transferring to your hotel. After checking in, take some time to freshen up and relax in your room. If you have the energy, consider wandering around the hotel area. In the evening, enjoy a stroll through Thamel, the vibrant tourist hub, known for its local shops, cafes, and souvenirs. To wrap up your first day, indulge in a private rooftop dinner with stunning views of the valley or stupa. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 2: Full-Day Sightseeing in Kathmandu

This day is dedicated to exploring the rich culture of the Kathmandu valley. After a hearty breakfast, embark on a private guided tour of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Your first stop will be the Pashupatinath Temple, a revered Hindu temple situated along the Bagmati River, where you can observe sacred rituals and cremation ghats. Next, you'll visit the Boudhanath Stupa, one of the largest Buddhist stupas in Asia, where you can immerse yourself in Tibetan culture, marvel at prayer wheels, and watch monks circumambulating under fluttering prayer flags. Afterward, head to Kathmandu Durbar Square to explore the historic Hanuman Dhoka Palace, Kumari Ghar, and local artisan shops. Your final destination for the day will be the Swayambhunath Stupa, also known as the Monkey Temple, which offers panoramic views of the city from its summit. You may also witness any ceremonies taking place at the temple. Don't miss the opportunity to capture the beauty of Newari architecture and vibrant street life. Lunch will be provided along the way, and in the evening, you can discover cozy cafes and rooftop

restaurants that boast Himalayan vistas.

Day 3: Kathmandu to Pokhara (Flight) + Sightseeing

Rise early for your flight to Pokhara, which lasts about 30 minutes. Upon arrival, you will check into your hotel and prepare for an exciting day of sightseeing. Begin with a visit to Davis Falls, a stunning waterfall famously accessed via an underground river. Next, explore the sacred Gupteshwar Cave, home to a revered Shiva lingam located near the falls. Afterwards, enjoy a boat ride on Phewa Lake to visit the Tal Barahi Temple on the island. If you're feeling adventurous, optional activities like paragliding and ziplining are available. In your free time after sightseeing, take a stroll around the lakeside shops, cafes, and local markets. In the evening, don't miss the short drive to Sarangkot for breathtaking sunset views of Annapurna and Machhapuchare. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 4: Pokhara to Ghandruk (Drive - approx. 3 hrs)

Start your day with a picturesque drive to Nayapol, which takes about 1.5 hours. This is the starting point for trekking in the region. From Nayapol, begin a delightful 3-hour trek to Ghandruk, passing scenic terraced fields, waterfalls, rivers, Machapuchare (Fishtail), and Annapurna South, along with local villages. The interactions with the Gurung community along the way add a special touch to your trek. Upon reaching Ghandruk, take time to explore the village and interact with locals. A visit to the Gurung Museum will provide insight into the rich history and culture of the Gurung people. If you're up for it, you can take a short hike to the Ghandruk viewpoint for stunning views of Machapuchare and Annapurna South. In the evening, enjoy the sunset over the breathtaking Annapurna range. Overnight stay in Ghandruk.

Day 5: Ghandruk to Pokhara

On this day, you'll trek back to Nayapul and then drive back to Pokhara. Wake up early for a short sunrise hike to a local viewpoint for magnificent views of the Himalayas, including Annapurna and Machapuchare. After your trek to Nayapul, drive back to Pokhara. Once there, you can unwind at your hotel or take a short hike or drive to visit the World Peace Pagoda for views over Fewa Lake. Relax by the lakeside with a coffee or enjoy a boat ride. Adventure seekers can choose from activities like zip-lining, paragliding, or mountain biking. Spend the evening strolling around the lakeside area. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 6: Flight from Pokhara to Kathmandu - Drive to Nagarkot

Prepare for a morning flight to Kathmandu, taking about 30 minutes, filled with spectacular views of the Himalayan range, hills, forests, and terraced fields. After arriving at the airport, head to Nagarkot, which takes approximately 2 hours. Once you check into your hotel or resort, relax or take a short nature walk around the village. As the evening falls, witness the stunning sunset over the Himalayas, including Mount Everest on clear days. Overnight stay in Nagarkot.

Day 7: Nagarkot Sunrise - Bhaktapur - Kathmandu

Rise early to witness a breathtaking sunrise over the Himalayas from the scenic viewpoints in Nagarkot. After soaking in the beauty, enjoy a hearty breakfast at your hotel. Next, you'll set off for Bhaktapur, where you can delve into the rich history of Bhaktapur Durbar Square, marvel at the intricate architecture of Nyatapola Temple and Dattatreya Temple, and explore the fascinating 55-Window Palace. Don't miss out on trying the local specialty, juju dhau, also known as king curd—a delicious yogurt crafted by the locals. As you wander through the local pottery and woodcraft shops, you'll get a

taste of the vibrant traditional markets. Once you've finished exploring Bhaktapur, you'll head back to Kathmandu. In the evening, consider enjoying a cultural show featuring traditional music and dance or indulging in some last-minute shopping at Thamel or Asan Bazaar. Overnight stays will be in Kathmandu.

Day 8: Departure

After a restful night, start your day with breakfast at the hotel and gather your belongings for your flight. Depending on your flight schedule, our representative will assist you in transferring to Tribhuvan International Airport. You'll leave Nepal with cherished memories of its stunning mountains, rich culture, and warm hospitality.
