Moreover, this tour offers a rare combination of high-altitude spirituality, natural beauty, cultural sites, and Tibetan-influenced culture.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in kathmandu [1,330m]

Upon your arrival at Tribhuvan International Airport in Kathmandu, a member of our team will be there to greet you and guide you to your hotel. After settling in, you'll receive an overview of your itinerary from a knowledgeable representative. In the evening, feel free to unwind at your hotel or venture out to explore the nearby local markets, cafés, and restaurants.

Day 2: Kathmandu sightseeing

Today's plan is packed with a full day of guided sightseeing in Kathmandu, led by a certified guide. You'll visit several UNESCO World Heritage sites, starting with Kathmandu Durbar Square, which encompasses a former royal palace, temples, and courtyards. Next, you'll make your way to Bouddhanath Stupa, one of the largest stupas in Asia and a prominent Buddhist pilgrimage site. Then, you'll visit the Pashupatinath Temple, one of the holiest Hindu temples in the world, followed by Swayambhunath Stupa, also known as the Monkey Temple, which offers breathtaking views of the city. Throughout the tour, you'll gain insights into Nepali history, architecture, and religion. A local lunch stop will give you the chance to savour traditional Nepali or Newari dishes (optional). After returning from your sightseeing adventure, you'll receive your final briefing about the helicopter tour and some packing tips.

Day 3: Flight from kathmandu to pokhara and sightseeing [822m / 25 minutes]

From Kathmandu Airport, you'll take a scenic 25-minute flight to Pokhara, where you'll be treated to stunning aerial views of the Langtang, Manaslu, and Annapurna mountain ranges. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and prepare for sightseeing in Pokhara. Highlights include Davis Falls, an underground waterfall steeped in legend; Gupteshwor Cave, a sacred shrine known for its natural rock formations; the Seti River Gorge, where you can admire the deep white-water gorge; and Phewa Lake, where you can enjoy an optional boat ride to Barahi Temple on the island. In the evening, you can relax at lakeside cafés, enjoy live music, or indulge in a spa treatment or ayurvedic massage.

Day 4: Morning Helicopter flight from Pokhara to Muktinath [3,700m]

Prepare for an early morning departure from Pokhara to Muktinath Temple, weather permitting, for optimal flying conditions. This scenic helicopter round trip takes about 45 minutes, offering breathtaking views of the Annapurna, Dhaulagiri, and Nilgiri mountain ranges, as well as the world's deepest gorge and the arid landscapes of Mustang. Once you land, you'll have a short walk of about 5 to 10 minutes to reach the temple, a significant pilgrimage site for both Hindus and Buddhists. You can partake in a sacred bath at the 108 water spouts if you wish. Following your visit to Muktinath, you'll also explore Wala Mai Temple, known for its eternal flame, during a brief darshan of the tranquil temple complex. Afterwards, you'll return to Pokhara, giving you some free time to explore nearby areas or enjoy shopping at the lakeside.

Day 5: Flight back to kathmandu from pokhara [1,330m / 25 minutes]

You'll take a scenic morning flight back to Kathmandu, which lasts about 25 minutes. Once you check into your hotel, take some time to explore Thamel or the local markets

for shopping. You can also opt for additional activities, such as visiting Patan Durbar Square or Bhaktapur—both UNESCO sites—or simply relax in the Garden of Dreams, enjoying rooftop cafés. In the evening, you'll gather for a farewell dinner, featuring a cultural dance performance and authentic Nepali cuisine.

Day 6: Departure

On your last day, our representative will assist you with hotel checkout and arrange for your drop-off three hours before your international flight. Thus, your unforgettable Muktinath helicopter tour comes to a close, leaving you with cherished memories to last a lifetime. t your life.
