Duration

The schedule is flexible, offering morning and afternoon slots, with mornings generally providing more stable flying conditions. Best Season

Autumn (September to November) and Spring (March to May) are considered the best seasons. Autumn: Clear skies, stable wind conditions, and excellent mountain views.

Spring: Blooming forests and mild weather enhance the overall experience.

Avoid the monsoon (June to August) due to heavy rain and low visibility.

Winter (December to February) can also be good, but mornings are recommended due to stronger afternoon winds.
