A flexible schedule is offered with morning and afternoon slots, though mornings are often favored for their steadier flying conditions. It's the perfect half-day adventure, leaving ample time for other sightseeing or activities.

1. Autumn (September to November) Best overall season for paragliding

Clear skies, stable wind conditions, and excellent visibility

Moderate temperatures

Panoramic views of the Annapurna and Dhaulagiri ranges

High tourist season – early booking recommended

2. Spring (March to May) Warm temperatures and strong thermals – ideal for longer flight durations

Blooming rhododendrons and lush greenery

Great visibility of the Himalayan peaks

Less crowded than autumn

DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Drive to Sarangkot hill from Hotel

08:00 AM - Hotel pickup and drive to Sarangkot

08:30 AM - Arrival at take-off site, safety briefing & gear check

09:00 AM - Start tandem paragliding flight (20-30 mins duration)

09:30 AM - Landing near Lakeside, photo/video collection

10:00 AM - Drop-off at hotel or free time near Phewa Lake
